



Southern California Bouvier des Flandres Club, Inc.

Membership Application

The **Southern California Bouvier des Flandres Club, Inc.** is a 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization formed to advance and promote the breeding and training of purebred Bouvier des Flandres under the rules and regulations of the **American Kennel Club**. Monies obtained by the Club are devoted to the above purposes and/or charitable or civic organizations. Membership is not restricted by locality, but the primary focus of the club is to represent and support Bouvier breeders, participants in conformation, working and performance trials, Bouvier rescue, and fanciers in the greater Los Angeles and Southern California region. Members in all membership categories are invited to participate in Club activities and entitled to receive the Club newsletter and publications.

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Voting Memberships:

Regular Membership

- Open to all persons 18 years or older, who are in good standing with the AKC, and subscribe to the purposes of the Club to represent breeders, exhibitors and fanciers of the Bouvier des Flandres breed in the Greater Los Angeles/Southern California region.
- Regular members have one vote in club elections
- Eligibility requirements include ○ Applicant sponsorship by two (2) voting members of the club who are in good standing
- Current ownership or part ownership of a Bouvier des Flandres dog or bitch by the applicant or spouse

Fee: \$40 /yr

Household Membership

- Available for two or more persons living in the same household who subscribe to the purposes of the Club.
- Household memberships are limited to two (2) votes in Club elections.
- Eligibility requirements include ○ Household sponsorship by two voting members of the club who are in good standing
- Current ownership or part ownership of a Bouvier des Flandres dog or bitch by at least one of the household members.

Fee: \$45 /yr

Non-voting Memberships:

Junior Membership

- Open to any person under 18 years of age, who is in good standing with the American Kennel Club and subscribes to the purposes of this Club
- Junior applicants must be sponsored by two (2) members in good standing with the Club.
- Junior members are NOT entitled to vote on Club matters and are ineligible to hold Club officer or Board positions.
- A Junior member shall become a Regular member with all the rights and privileges attached thereto for the remainder of the membership year in which they turn eighteen (18) years of age. At the conclusion the

membership year in which they turn 18, a former Junior member is eligible to apply for membership in any of the other membership categories.

- Dues of Junior members will be two-thirds (2/3) that of the Regular membership and will remain at that level until the end of the membership year in which they turn eighteen (18) years of age.

Fee: \$25 /yr

Associate Membership:

- Open to any person and entitles participation in all club activities
- No sponsorship or owner requirement
- Ineligible to vote in Club elections or to serve as Club officer or Board member.

Fee: \$36 /yr

A one-time administrative fee of \$6.50 must be included with your application. The applicant (s) must complete both sides of this application form and return it along with the yearly dues fee and the administrative fee to the Secretary of the Club. The membership year runs from June 1st through May 31st of the next calendar year.
